THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- 1. Font: Arial, Calibri, Times New Roman
- 2. Font Size: 9/10 OR 11, for heading 12 will be good enough
- 3. Spacing: MS word Justified (the usual one) 1.0
- 4. Narrow margining
- 5. Writing should be left side justified
- 6. Do not include page number in your CV
- 7. Finish your CV within one page unless you have a long list of important publications, projects or many years of work experience & certifications.
- 8. Make it simple and formal
- 9. Always remember the post, organization, country context before writing up your CV.
- 10. Follow the reverse chronological order when listing education, work experience, projects and so on, recent one comes first.
- 11. You do not have to include your full address if you are posting the CV to a public platform or if you are not comfortable giving it. Including the city with the zip/postal code will be enough.
- 12. At the Project section, you are requested to mention your best 2 or 3 projects that will lead the employer to connect your abilities with the position they are looking for.

It is not mandatory to follow the same format and talk exactly the way mentioned in the SAMPLE CV, you are free to use the numerous templates with different designs available online however it is strongly recommended to follow the guidelines given here.
